Area IX Young Riders
Sportsmanship & Leadership (S&L) Point Program

- Young Riders who have registered and paid dues through USEA earn points for:
 - Participation in a YR Project or Fundraiser
 - Hosting & Organizing a YR Meeting
 - Mentorship of a fellow YR (two riding levels apart) – extra points if from a different barn, even more if from another state in Area IX
 - Unpaid working student for Area IX rider (two riding levels apart) same extra point options
 - Volunteer at a USEA Recognized Event or in Preparation for one
 - Volunteer for Saddle UP!

- Riders will present a form to be verified with signature and phone number to submit to the YR Coordinator. Each quarter the points will be totaled and posted to the Young Rider Sportsmanship & Leadership Leader Board.

- High Point award each quarter will be a scholarship to an upcoming YR Clinic. Points received by the end of each quarter (3/31, 6/30, 9/30 and 12/31) will be totaled and posted to the Leader Board on www.areaixeventing.com The annual Young Rider Sportsmanship award will be based on these points.

- To be selected to represent Area IX for NAJYRC, in addition to the qualifications stated by FEI, USEF and USEA:
 - Riders must personally earn 50 Sportsmanship / Leadership Points prior to 4 weeks before the first day of Dressage at NAJYRC.
 - Riders who do not participate in at least 1 fundraising activity will agree to be billed for their portion of all expenses.
